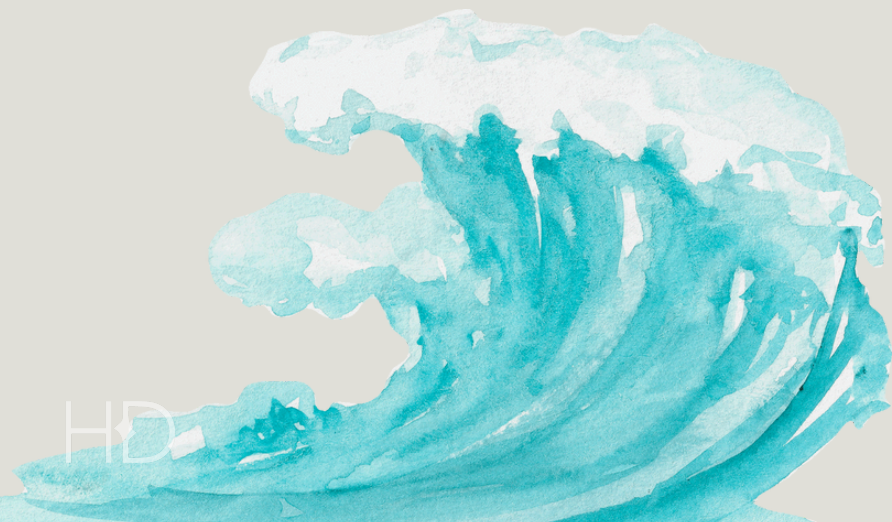

Prison Island

Prison Island, also known as Changuu Island, is a small, idyllic islet off the coast of Stone Town, Zanzibar. Originally intended as a detention center for rebellious slaves, it later served as a quarantine station. Today, it's a popular tourist spot known for its crystal-clear waters, rich marine life, and a sanctuary for giant Aldabra tortoises, some over 100 years old. You will learn about its history, visit the tortoises and enjoy its pristine beaches.



Stone town tour

Stone Town, the historic heart of Zanzibar City, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its maze of narrow alleys, bustling markets, and unique blend of African, Arab, Indian, and European influences. This cultural hub features iconic landmarks and architecture, including mosques like the Malindi Mosque, reflects Islamic influences.. We will explore paths surrounded by intricately carved wooden doors, vibrant markets, and the rich history of the spice and slave trades.



Museum visit

Zanzibar's museums and palaces offer a glimpse into its rich history and cultural heritage. The House of Wonders (Beit-el-Ajaib), a grand palace turned museum, showcases Swahili culture and Zanzibar's maritime history. The Palace Museum (Beit al-Sahel), once the Sultan's residence, displays royal artifacts and stories of Zanzibar's Omani rulers. The Old Dispensary is a beautifully restored building highlighting colonial-era architecture. Each site combines fascinating history with stunning design, making them essential stops for history enthusiasts.



Mnemba Island

Mnemba Island, a private paradise off Zanzibar's northeastern coast, is renowned for its pristine beaches, vibrant coral reefs, and crystal-clear waters. A marine conservation area surrounds the island, making it a hotspot for snorkeling and diving. The waters near Mnemba are also home to playful pods of dolphins, offering visitors the chance to swim alongside these magnificent creatures in their natural habitat, creating unforgettable tropical memories. You will get the chance to snorkle with the tropical fish and dolphins here.



Quadbike trip

Zanzibar quad bike tour offers an exciting way to explore the island's diverse landscapes, from lush plantations and remote villages to sandy trails and scenic coastlines. This guided tour will take you off the beaten path, providing a unique mix of adventure and cultural immersion. Along the way, you can interact with locals, discover hidden gems, and enjoy breathtaking views, making it a thrilling experience.



Spice Tour

Zanzibar is famous for its rich spice heritage, earning the nickname "Spice Islands." The island produces a variety of aromatic spices, including cloves, nutmeg, cinnamon, and black pepper. Jozani forest

You will cook popular dishes like biryani, pilau, and curries, while also gaining insight into Zanzibar's culinary heritage. It's a hands-on way to immerse in the island's flavours and take home new cooking skills.



Salaam Cave, located on Zanzibar's southern coast, is a beautiful, tranquil spot known for its crystal-clear waters and dramatic limestone formations. It's a great place for swimming and exploring the cave's unique rock structures. Nearby, visitors can also encounter endangered green turtles, as the area serves as a sanctuary for these marine creatures. you have the chance to feed and swim with the turtles.

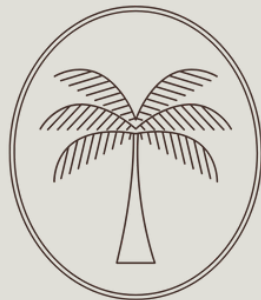
